Proposal to change the appointment of Standing Committee,

Current Method:

Standing

Area Chair is responsible for appointing the Steering Committee Chair

Proposed Change:

standing

Have all area officers jointly appoint Steering Committee Chairs.

Proposed mechanism of selection:

Each officer can submit candidates to be considered for respective chair position. If more than one person is submitted for a specific committee, area officers will review all candidates and attempt to reach a consensus on candidate to be selected as chair. If unable to reach a consensus, area officers will then utilize the third legacy voting procedure to offer chair position.

Changes to Structure and Guidelines:

- Remove "appointment of standing committee chairs" from area chair job description.
- Add "In conjunction with other area officers, appoint standing committee chairs"

Background:

Area officers have been discussing ways to better support the standing committees. I took the concern about better ways to support standing committees and what is area chair oversight responsibilities to this year's PRAASA. I learned that many areas in pacific region appoint there standing committee chairs via group decision of either a steering committee or panel of officers. It was suggested that this provided for better support for standing committee chairs and provided a better means for addressing any concerns that might arise with standing committees within a panel. I discussed some of the specifics of this selection model with various pacific region area chairs and thought this selection method had merit and deserved dialogue from our area assembly.
