## **GSR**

2.	Am I responsible as a GSR?  Do I attend my group's business meeting (or home group) meetings?  If I cannot make an Area or a District meeting do I take the responsibility of making sure my alternate GSR or another representative from my group will be there?
3.	Do I make regular announcements at my group's AA meetings informing the group about the work that Area and District are doing to carry the message?
4.	Do I know what my role is in my group conscience?
