As we have seen in the past, the expenditures in the first part of the year are higher than income. The costs of the General Service Conference, PRAASA, two Assemblies and two Committee Meeting all come due in the first five months of the year. Since the start of this year, our expenditures totaled \$15,340.68 with contributions totaling \$9,915.46. However, expenditures should decrease over the next few months allowing us to move into the positive as we have seen in the past.

Today we are presenting the proposed 2014 budget for Hawai'i Area. The finance committee has worked hard to gather the necessary information to put the budget together. During the next few months, the finance committee would be happy to present the budget at your district meetings. I have included a brief narrative to accompany the proposed budget to provide background regarding the line item dollar amounts. Today at lunch, the Finance Committee (Steve N., Tami G., Colleen A., Alejandro/Ron A. and myself), will be meeting to discuss budget presentations and other miscellaneous finance committee business. I want to thank the finance committee for their continued service, especially during the lunch break.

If you would like me to put your travel costs on the area debit card, please talk to me and we can do this together! Don't forget to use the Area's Hawaiian Airlines code.
