

## Using the Area Website

**When/where is the next assembly or committee meeting?** Go to <http://www.area17aa.org> and look in the Aloha page. The upcoming events are listed. If an event is highlighted, you can click on it and go to the calendar entry to find out more. Or go to the calendar page and look for the events there.

**Get materials for the next assembly or committee meeting.** There are a few places that you can find the materials for assemblies and committee meetings. The materials can be downloaded from the event listing on the calendar. Alternatively, they can be found under the tab "Service Materials", then then "Assemblies and Committee Meetings". Scroll down to the gathering you are interested in and the materials are listed for downloading.

**Find information about your district.** Navigate to your district via the tab "Districts" at the top of any main page to find the location, time and date of your district meeting, your DCM contact info, your district mailing address, your district newsletter, etc.

**Read the latest issues of the Myna Bird.** You can get to the latest issues of the Mynah Bird by clicking on the sketch of the bird on the Aloha page, or you can go to the Myna Bird Standing Committee page by going to the "Standing Committees" tab, then the "Myna Bird" choice from the list.

**Submit information to the archives.** Go to the "Standing Committees" tab, then choose "Archives" from the list to go to the Archives Standing Committee page, where you can find forms to fill out to submit group stories, log-timer stories, and more!

**Catch up on other standing committee activity.** Go to the "Standing Committees" tab and choose any standing committee from the list to see what they are doing.

**Link to Intergroup, PRAASA, the International Convention, etc. from the "links" section of the Aloha page.**

**Please note:** The GSR's primary source of information is their DCM. Attend your district meeting to find out what's happening! Go to the website for additional information and backup. The DCM's primary source of information is the Committee Meeting. The DCMs and standing committee chairs also receive important information through their email. **So it is very important for DCMs and standing committee chairs to use their area emails.**

**Search.** You can always use the search function if you can't find what you are seeking, use it!

**A word about the email lists:** We have set up several email lists, which you can find listed on the web site standing committee page. There are a few rules:

1. Only people belonging to the list can send to the list.
2. Only the webmaster can add or delete members.
3. The list cannot exceed 100 members.
