

Honolulu International Airport to Camp Homelani

- Depart Airport Terminal and stay left to merge onto H1 west; toward Waianae, Pearl City etc. Stay on H1 for 6.8 miles
- 2. Take H1 until the H2 Exit (N /Mililani /Wahiawa). Merge onto H2 Stay on H2 for 8.3 miles
- 3. At the end of the freeway stay left to merge on to Wilikina Drive. Wilikina will pass Schofield Barracks and turn into Kaukonahua (HI-803) after about 1.9 miles. Kaukonahua will then turn into Farrington (State Hwy 930) after about 4 miles. The road changes names but you probably won't notice it.
- 4. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit to continue onto Farrington (State Hwy.930).
- 5. In 2.1 miles turn right onto Olohio; Camp Homelani will be on the left down by the ocean. Olohio can sneak up on you; when you see the green Tsunami warning siren on your right, Olohio is coming up.
