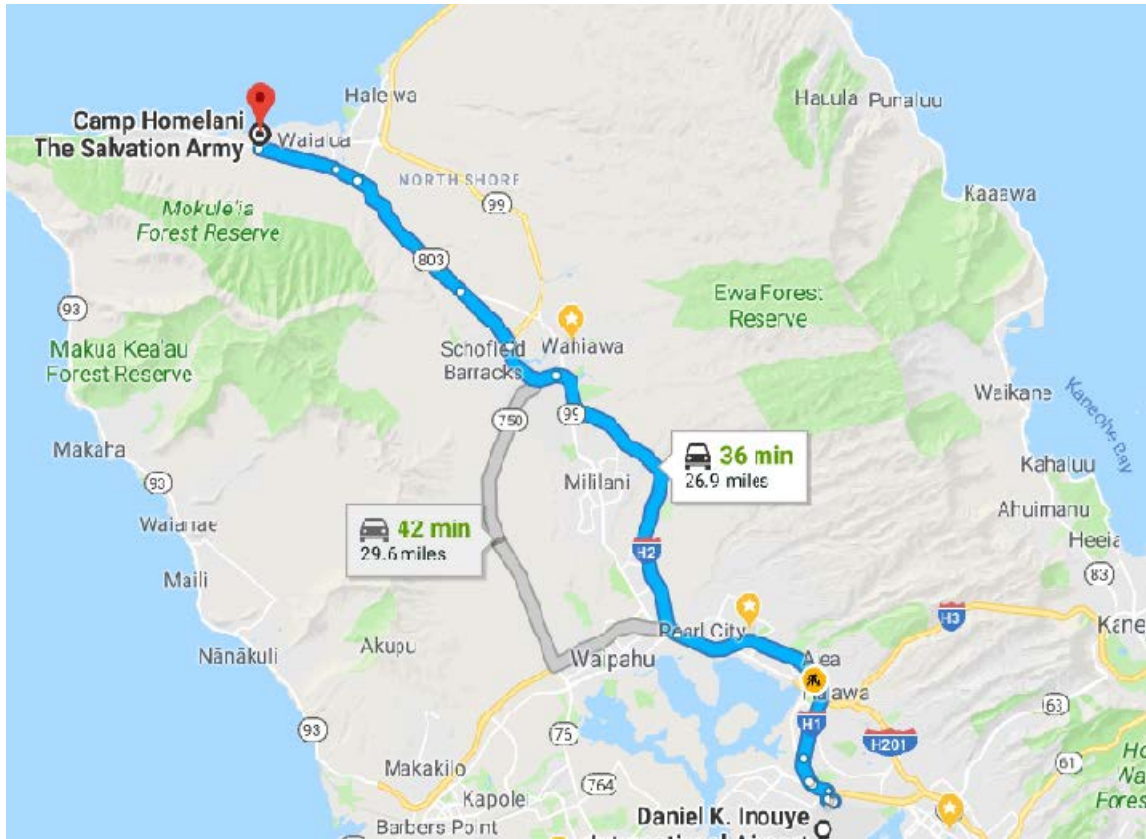

Honolulu International Airport to Camp Homelani

1. Depart Airport Terminal and stay left to merge onto H1 west; toward Waianae, Pearl City etc. Stay on H1 for 6.8 miles
2. Take H1 until the H2 Exit (N /Mililani /Wahiawa). Merge onto H2 Stay on H2 for 8.3 miles
3. At the end of the freeway stay left to merge on to Wilikina Drive. Wilikina will pass Schofield Barracks and turn into Kaukonahua (HI-803) after about 1.9 miles. Kaukonahua will then turn into Farrington (State Hwy 930) after about 4 miles. The road changes names but you probably won't notice it.
4. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit to continue onto Farrington (State Hwy.930).
5. In 2.1 miles turn right onto Olohio; Camp Homelani will be on the left down by the ocean. Olohio can sneak up on you; when you see the green Tsunami warning siren on your right, Olohio is coming up.
