General Manager's Report

<u>Administrative Services</u>- The records department is processing the backlog of GSR, DCM, DCMC, and New Groups kits, fulfilling over 1,200 kit requests.

<u>Archives-</u> Saint Thomas Hospital, where Dr. Bob and Sister Ignatia worked and helped many alcoholics, will be closed soon. Pictures of the current exhibit held at St. Thomas were received and are now a part of G.S.O.'s archival photo collection.

Staff Report

<u>C.P.C/ Treatment – The LinkedIn page is now live.</u>

There will be C.P.C. exhibits in 27 areas within 7 regions of the U.S. and Canada.

<u>Corrections</u>- Receives requests from inmates for Grapevine and La Viña subscriptions. These subscriptions are appreciated by inmates and considered essential to their sobriety.

Finance (as of Oct 31,2019)

Revenues were 0.91% higher than budgeted.

Operating expenses were 5.35% greater than budgeted.

Actual Contributions: \$7,013,382.00.

Online contributions: \$ 741,424. (10.60% of total cont.)

Publishing (as of Oct 31,2019)

Actual gross sales of \$954,918 was below budget.

Web sales accounts for 69% of sales.

Digital books sales: 40,707 units were distributed.
