

Treasurer's Report  
Election Assembly November 19-20, 2022

Thank you, Honolulu District 2 for hosting this Area Election Assembly, our final meeting of the 2-year panel. Thanks to everyone who has participated in Area service over the past two years. Thank you to all the Group Treasurers and Individuals who have continued to send in your contributions so we can make sure AA remains available to anyone in Hawaii who wants and needs help to obtain and maintain sobriety.

Hawai'i Area 17 spent more money than we received this year, and we are still in very good shape financially. Thank you for your individual and Group contributions - as of November 12, 2022 we have received **\$28,878.03**. We also received \$0.84 interest in the Prudent Reserve and \$0.65 interest for PRAASA 2026 Reserve, for total inflow of **\$28,879.52**.

Expenses paid as of November 12, 2022 were **\$33,596.64**.

We did spend \$4,717.12 more than we received so far, and that is OK, because we had a surplus in 2021. We also pre-paid \$425 to District 8 for hosting the 2023 Orientation Assembly next January.

## Treasurer's Report

Our 2022 expenses, by Priority of spending as of November 12, 2022:

1) Delegate Expenses: \$10,116.33 This includes the half of the expensed for our Delegate's reports back to the Districts. Our number one priority also included our \$6,200 supplemental contribution to support the General Service Conference when the General Service office asked Areas for additional contributions this year. This was possible because we received \$16,320 more than we spent in 2021.

2) Area Assembles and Committee Meetings: \$ 9,551.10, which includes facility rental costs for the Budget and Election Assemblies and food for the Budget Assembly. We will be paying for the meal for the Election Assembly also.

3) Area Standing Service Committees: \$ 5,174.59

4) Area Operating Expenses: \$4,952.14

5) Service Events (Delegate, Chair attendance at PRAASA and Regional Forums;): \$3,802.48.
