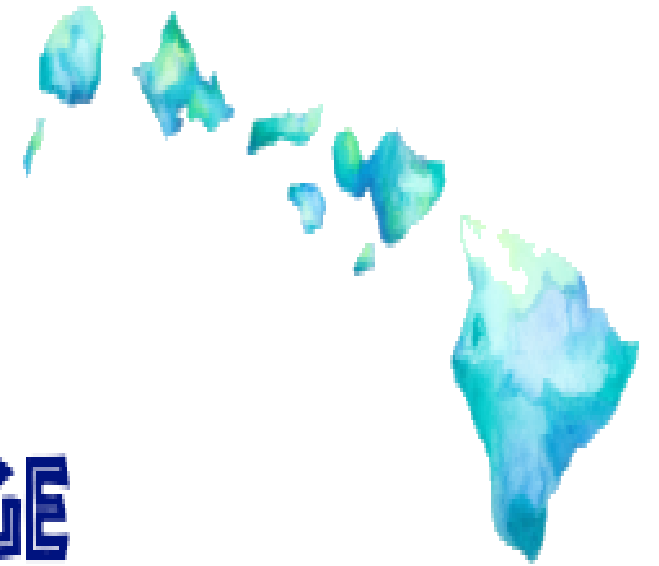

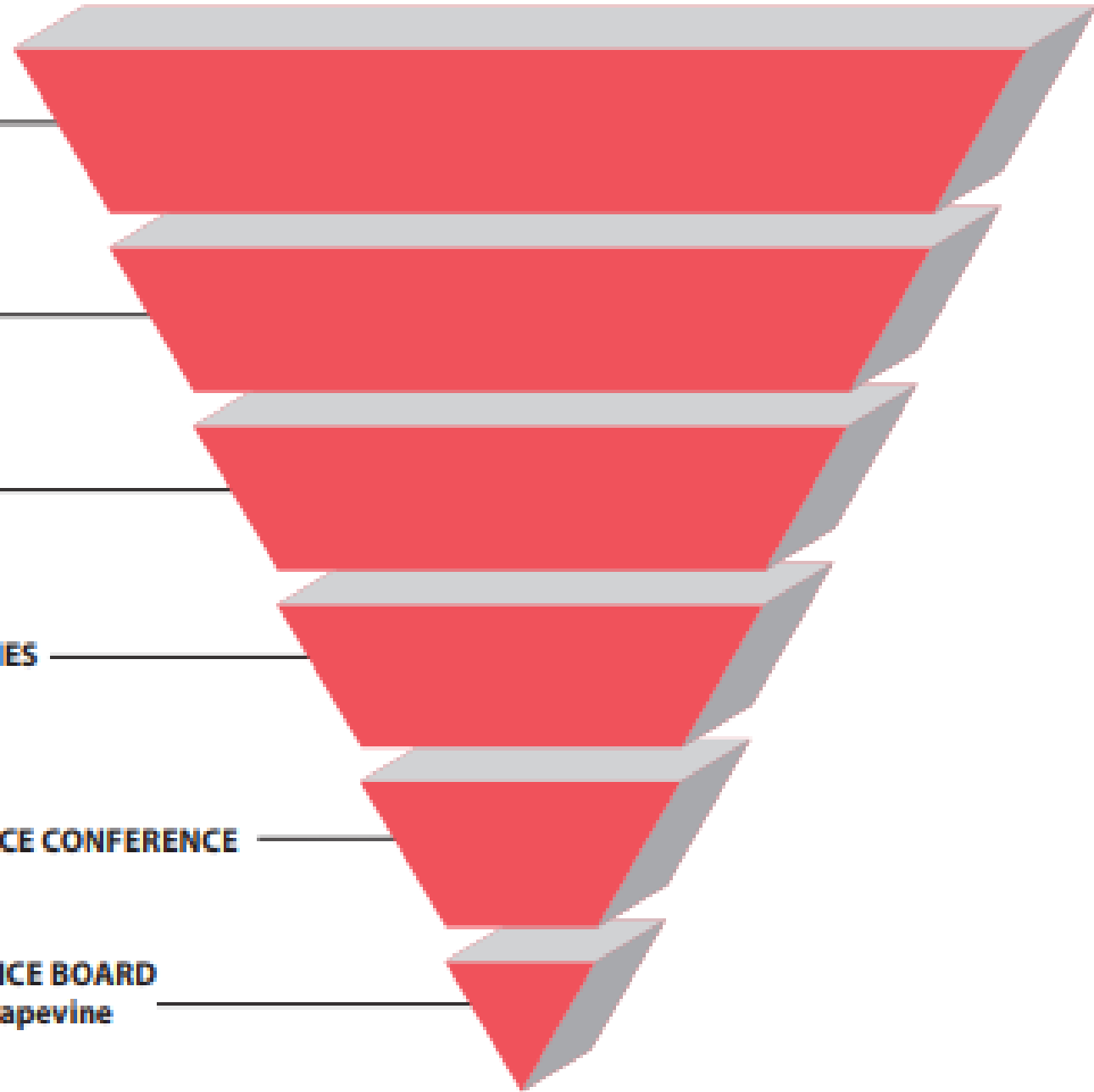

- PRAASA Communication.

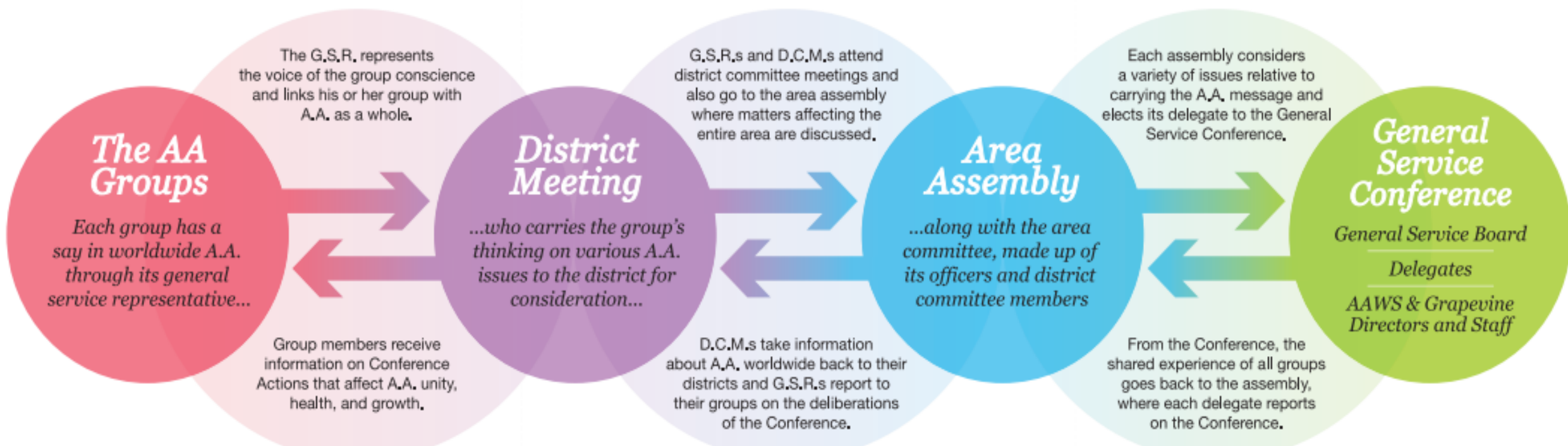
GSO
