- Assemblies

 - Schedule flights to arrive no later than 7:30 AM Saturday and depart after 5:45 PM Sunday.
 - Register with the Area Registrar at your first assembly.
 - Check in with Area Registrar before start of each assembly to receive a voting slip. You will also need to check in with the hosting district's registrar.
- Read and review all the suggested literature, especially:

 - G.S.R. Orientation Informational Handbook (available on www.area17aa.org)
 - Hawaii Area 17 Structure and Guidelines for Area 17 General Service (available on www.area17aa.org)
