This gives the english speaking part of the fellowship insight into what they experience and has fostered new levels of compassion and working together. I got to speak about our outreach efforts in one of the round table discussions and listened to many other community issues in other areas. Ronnie D shared some wonderful analogies about working with young Shoshone alcoholics.

We will have the PRAASA report back March 31st noon to 2:30pm where I will speak more about my experience there. Potluck at 12:30 and speakers starting at 1:00pm until 2:30pm or longer. At the Cameron Center in Wailuku.

I went to Molokai Monday til Tuesday. I got picked up by Rocky who drove me around, looked at cats, talked story and got some food. I went to a 5:30pm Alanon meeting and got a ride from there to the 7:00pm hospital AA meeting. I got to spend a little time with Don D. and after the meeting I stayed at Jerry and Chasity's house. The next morning I went to a meeting of another fellowship and then raced to the airport to catch a flight back to Maui.

-I talked to Jeff who ran the hospital meeting called the Friendly Island Fellowship Meeting. They have never had a GSR before and are not sure that they need one. He said he will call their annual meeting to do their annual financial splits and bring up the topic of GSR and see what people think. Jerry was initially interested in being GSR but after some though his family commitments would not allow it.
