That letter was returned by the institution for unknown reasons so I requested a different contact from GSO. I was given another fellows info, wrote to him, and just received a letter back yesterday. I do not know if there is still a shortage of male AA members to connect with inmates but this is an excellent 12 step service opportunity. I am corresponding with a guy in Texas who is on the last leg of a 12 year sentence. If you have never done this type of service I would recommend it.
- I spoke with Michelle, the DCM for Kihei District, and was informed that they are putting on a workshop October 5 th. They have the room behind the Bridge Club reserved from 7a-1p. They invited Tri-Isle District and us to participate. I told her that we would. They do not have format or agenda yet but they have some ideas and they invite us to help plan it. The theme is supposed to be "We are not a glum lot". Michelle is supposed to let me know when the next planning meeting is so that No Ka Oi may be represented. When I find out I will send an email to the district contacts. If you are especially interested in helping let me know.
- I wanted to remind everyone that online registration will be available September 9 th for the 2020 International Convention which will be in Detroit July 2-5, 2020. Advance registration for the Convention (between September 9 th, 2019 and April 14 th, 2020) will be \$115 per attendee. After April 15 th, 2020 will be \$140.
